QUESTIONS FOCUSED ON CHILD ADHD SERVICES

This data relates to North East Lincolnshire; this service is now provided by Navigo (since 1 April 2023).

The dataset that we used for reporting the ADHD activity did not have gender included.

Child ADHD assessments in Lincolnshire are provided by the Community Paediatric team in ULHT.

2021-22 – 49 Assessments

2022-23 – 56 Assessments

2021-22 – 9.3 weeks

2021-22 – 6 Waiting

2022-23 – Cannot report as the Commissioning Contract ended on 31 March 2023. The service moved to NAVIGO.
