Thank you for your recent request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 received on 17 April 2023.

NHS Barnsley, Doncaster, Rotherham and Sheffield CCGs were statutory organisations between 1 April 2013 and 30 June 2022. From 1 July 2022 all statutory duties have been transitioned into the NHS South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board (ICB).
