I refer to your email of 15 May 2023 requesting information regarding Adult Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) services.

I can confirm on behalf of NHS Coventry and Warwickshire Integrated Care Board (ICB) and in accordance with S.1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) that we do hold some of the information that you have requested. Please see details of your request and the ICB's response below:

Response

- **Original Procurement Route Used - Adult and Children ASD and ADHD 2022-23 +2023/24**
ASD and ADHD services form part of a wider contract for Mental Health and Learning Disabilities services commissioned through our local NHS provider Coventry & Warwickshire NHS Partnership Trust (CWPT). Additional services are provided under patient choice guidelines but the ICB does not currently hold any direct contracts with any other providers.
- **Aggregate Value – ASD 2022/23**
Out-turn value of £7.316m but this cannot be split by adults and children
- **Aggregate Value – ADHD 2022/23**
Funding is through a block contract funding arrangement with main NHS provider (CWPT) for which the ICB is unable to split this out from main block contract value
- **Aggregate Value – ASD 2023/24**
Notional £6.2m projected value (as currently mid-year) for ASD in 23/24
- **Aggregate Value – ADHD 2023/24**
Funding is through a block contract funding arrangement with main NHS provider (CWPT) for which the ICB is unable to split this out from main block contract value
- **Term & Expiry date**
CWPT contract 1st April 2022 – 31st March 2023 and 1st April 2023- 31st March 2024
