Thank you for your freedom of information request received on 12th June 2026. We have responded to this request inline below.

I am writing to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 for the following information regarding ADHD assessments within Haydock Medical Centre. NHS Cheshire and Merseyside ICB advised us (FOI ref FOI/02002/CMICB) that this information is held by your organisation as a commissioned provider of adult ADHD assessment services

Adult ADHD Assessments

1. How many adults do you have waiting for an ADHD diagnosis at the moment?
Response - We currently have 3993 adults waiting for an ADHD diagnosis.
2. How many adults were given an ADHD Assessment in the last year (1st April 2025 - 31st March 2026)
Response - 0 adults were given an ADHD assessment in the last year (1st April 2025- 31st March 2026)
3. If an adult was referred to you now when would you expect them to be seen?
Response - Our service is currently mainly focused on managing patients who already have an ADHD diagnosis and we are only commissioned to see a very small number of new patients per year, consequently, it could take several years for a new patient to be seen within our service
4. Please describe your current Adult ADHD Assessment pathway
Response - All new referrals are clinically triaged by a senior clinician upon receipt. Accepted referrals are then added to a waiting list for an assessment and are contacted when an appointment becomes available. Assessments are then booked with a Psychiatrist as a 90-minute appointment.
5. How many children do you have waiting for an ADHD diagnosis at the moment?
Response - We are an adults service only
6. How many children were given an ADHD Assessment in the last year (1st April 2025 - 31st March 2026).
Response - We are an adults service only
7. If a child was referred to you now when would you expect them to be seen?
Response - We are an adults service only

8. Please describe your current Child ADHD Assessment pathway.

Response - We are an adults service only
